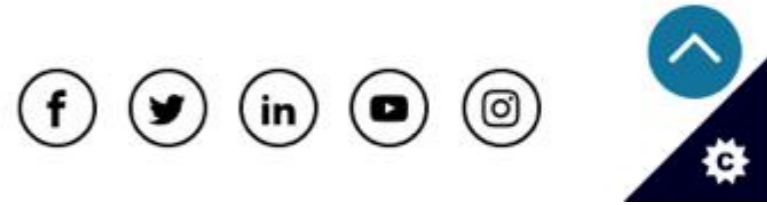

Mayo County Council administers the scheme, and an evaluation committee considers the applications in line with Mayo County Councils policy on community benefit contributions required for certain major developments.

The North Mayo Heritage Centre (NMHC) is dedicated to preserving and promoting the rich heritage of the region. The centre operates a Genealogy Service (with 1.2 million records), Museum, Conference Centre, Cafe and Organic Garden. The NMHC recorded visitor numbers of 24,000 in 2019.


NMHC was awarded a QQI level 4 educational programme in 2019 and a Community Education programme in 2021 from the ETB.

The NMHC is part of the POBAL funded CSP programme and operates TUS, RSS and CE schemes. The NMHC receives small amounts of funding from Mayo CoCo, mostly via the GMA funding.
